CONSULTATION

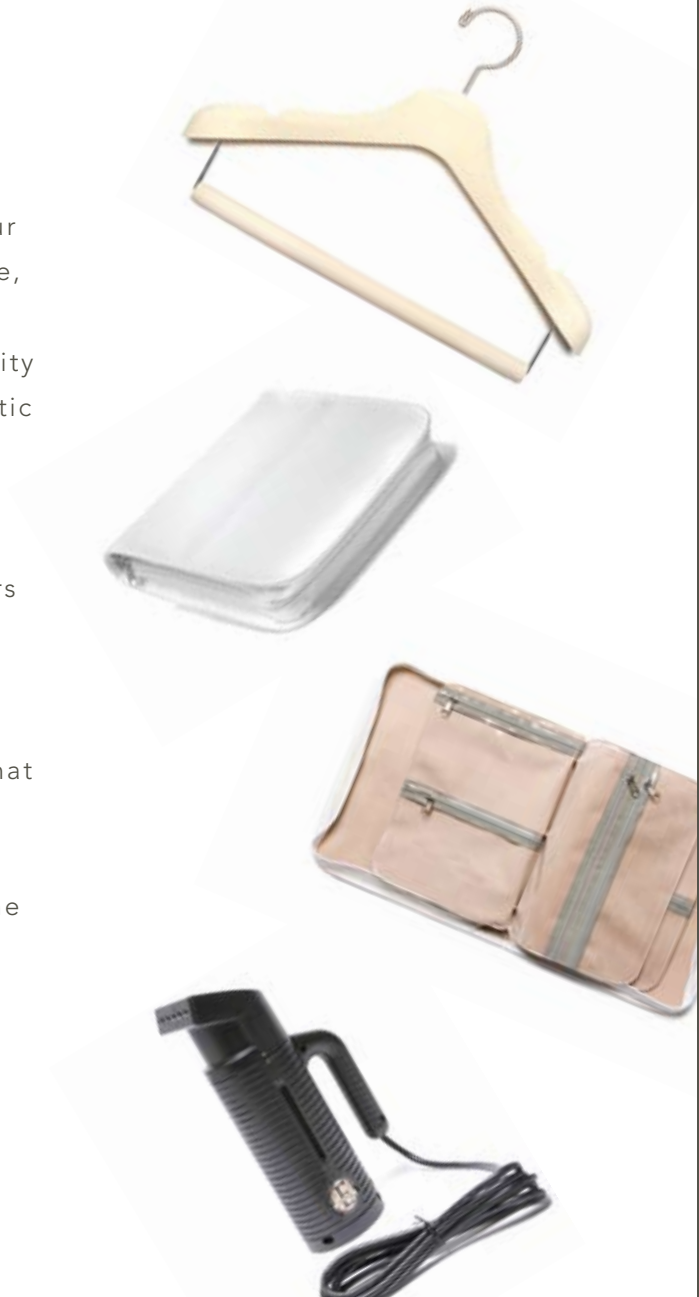

SERVICES AND FEES

CLOSET AND CABINET (HOLISTIC ORGANIZATIONAL DESIGN™):

Inventory, edit, design, build-out and install are the steps to achieving a functional and organized space. An initial consultation determines your budget and aesthetic preferences. We follow-up with an estimate. Our creative team develops a concept and our in-house designers draft plans. We have our own cabinet shop to build out whatever closet, cabinets or furniture we dream up for you, but we can also produce your decorator or architect's own vision.

Design: \$150-\$200 per hour for custom design (using standardized components and Clos-ette innovations), plus a 10-20% architectural administration fee. We work both on AutoCAD and by hand.

INTERIORS BY CLOS-ETTE:

At Clos-ette we not only build out all the cabinetry for your interiors to organize your rooms and your life, but also decorate the rooms we build out. We provide decorating services including spatial planning, sourcing and specifying window treatments, furniture, fabric, wall finishes, and flooring, and even total room renovations. Let us help you build out your dressing area, and turn it into a finished space for you as well.

Design Services Hourly Fees: \$150-\$200 an hour

Mark-up on Purchases: 30-50% Commission

COMMERCIAL, RETAIL AND SHOWROOM SPACES:

We'd like to help you organize your office or even create a streamlined layout for a showroom. Let us show you how the Clos-ette philosophy translates commercially to help your company develop, showcase and sell a better product. Each contract is negotiated separately based on individual job specs, time and materials.

CLOSET EDITING/INVENTORY/STYLIST WORK:

Initial Consultation: \$250-\$500-- one to two hours

Full day of shopping/wardrobe editing: \$3000-\$5000 - six hour day

**** Travel is not limited to any city, state or country. Travel expenses are paid for by the client (hotel, airfare, rental car (if needed), etc.). When flying to see a client, there is a minimum daily travel stipend of \$3000-\$5000 a day regardless of the hours spent. The full day rate constitutes a seven hour day. Additional daily hours can be requested by the client. Traveling time outside of New York City by car is also paid by the usual hourly or day rate. .****
